Tranquility awaits as we wander through the farm taking in the sights and scents surrounding us. Historically lavender has been thought to stimulate and supplement the body's healing forces unmatched by modern pharmaceuticals. In the Middle Ages, evidence suggests that lavender field workers and perfumers survived the Black Death and other plagues due to its protection against bacterial pathogens, and new scientific studies have confirmed these age-old beliefs. Lavender can stimulate the immune system but also soothes muscle aches and even take the pain out of insect bites. Another amazing finding with lavender is its ability to act as an anti-depressant that boosts your spirits and helps beat the blues.
